

4. ENFORCEMENT:

- A. Whenever any Village Board member shall find any vehicles or appliances as described herein placed or stored in the open upon private property within the Village, he shall report such findings to the Village Board as a whole and the Village Board shall then notify the owner of said property in writing of the aforesaid violation and if said vehicle or appliance is not removed within 5 days, the Village Board shall cause to be issued a citation to the property owner or tenants of the property upon which said vehicle or appliance is stored.
- B. If such vehicle or appliance is not removed within 10 days after issuance of a citation, the Village Board shall cause the vehicle or appliance to be removed and impounded and it shall thereafter be disposed of pursuant to Wisconsin Law. Any cost incurred in the removal and sale of said vehicle or appliance shall be recovered from the owner, however, if the owner of the vehicle or appliance cannot readily be found, the cost of such removal shall be charged to the property from which it is removed which charge shall be entered as a special charge on the tax roll.

5. PENALTY: Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance and shall be found guilty thereof shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$25.00 for each violation. Each motor vehicle or appliance involved shall constitute a separate offense.

6. APPLICABILITY: This ordinance shall be applicable only to the platted portion of the Village of Tony.

DUMPING RUBBISH

1. PROHIBITION: No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited in or upon any public or private waters or grounds in the Village any dead animals, rubbish, refuse, filth, offal or any other substance that would contaminate the said waters or grounds, that will obstruct or tend to obstruct any sidewalk, gutter, street or alley or that will in any manner create any bad or nauseous stench or nuisance or that will endanger or tend to endanger the public health; the Village Board is hereby empowered to summarily remove or cause to be removed any such dead animal, rubbish, refuse, filth, offal or other substance as so deposited contrary to the provisions of this section and cost of such removal shall be charged against the person violating this ordinance.

2. APPLICABILITY: This ordinance shall be applicable only to the platted portion of the Village of Tony.
