

ORDINANCE #72-1

VILLAGE OF TONY

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CLOSING HOURS FOR BEER AND LIQUOR TAVERNS IN THE VILLAGE OF TONY.

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF TONY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

ONE: No premises for which a retail liquor license or fermented malt beverage license has been issued shall be permitted to remain open between 1:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., except on January 1 when the closing hours shall be between 3:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., and during Daylight saving Time when the closing hours shall be between 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.

TWO: Any person, firm or corporation who violates any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars nor more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars together with the costs of prosecution for each violation and in default of payment thereof, shall be imprisoned in the county jail of Rusk County, Wisconsin, until payment of such forfeiture and costs, but not exceeding 30 day.

THREE: All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

FOUR: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication.
